



- Check sealing.







## Electronically controlled gasoline injection engine Fuel filter in engine compartment

## Fuel filter between rear axle and fuel tank

- Unscrew cover box.
- Take off pressure hoses.
- Loosen fixing screws (arrows) and remove filter.
- Unscrew connecting plug from removed filter and mount on new filter with new gasket.
- Install new filter in direction of flow.
- On CIS (continuous injection system) locate fuel filter in holder. For this purpose, slip filter into holder until holder is in center of transparent foil.
- Check for leaks.
