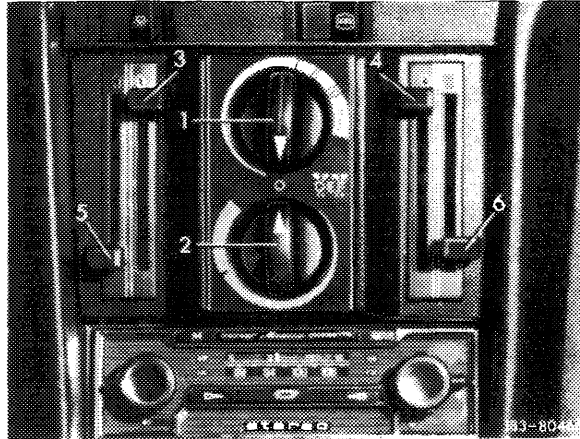
The following control panel illustrations and descriptions should help to determine the type of air conditioning system installed in your particular model.

This system is covered in Section 1.

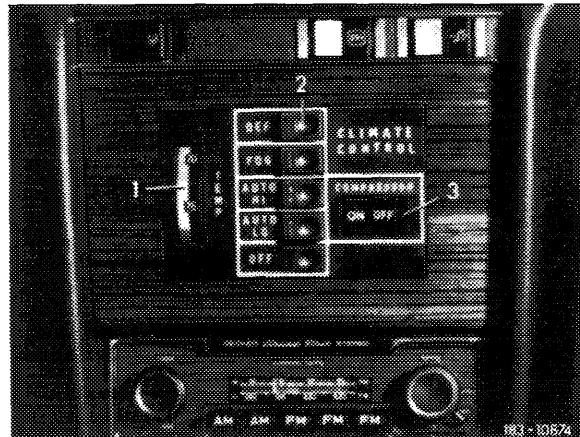
